

[Amy] A zone BFE's are never on the FIRM - to use that BFE to rate the policy, we will need a letter from the community that they accept the BFE

[ruth] what does that mean?

[ruth] Which community and why hasn't someone asked for this.

[Amy] The base flood elevation in a plain A flood zone is community determined - since the surveyor indicates that he took the BFE from another source, the community has to approve it

[Amy] we didn't have the complete elevation cert before and sometimes the verification is in the comments on page 2

[ruth] Which community - how do I contact them. What is your recommendation.

[ruth] I have never had this problem before.

[Amy] Sarasota County - I'd start with a building, planning or zoning office

[Amy] Let them know that you need community approval for a BFE in an unnumbered A zone

[ruth] Okay - what does BFE stand for

[Amy] base flood elevation

[ruth] Do you know where the source came from that he used, or should I ask him too?

[Amy] he says it came from the FIRM, which is the Flood Insurance Rate Map, but by definition, the A zone BFE does not come from the FIRM
