State of Florida party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations ~~between~~  
to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, enfeoffed, conveyed and con-  
firmed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release,  
enfeoff, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and its suc-  
cessors and assigns forever, all that certain parcel of land lying and being in the  
County of Sarasota and State of Florida, more particularly  
described as follows:



Begin at a concrete monument on the east shore  
of Casey's Key, which monument is the United  
States Government meander corner on the north  
line of Section 2, Township 39 South, Range 18  
East, thence West 560 feet more or less to the  
Gulf of Mexico, thence southerly 15° 0' East  
along the Gulf of Mexico 2600 feet for a point  
of beginning, thence East 478 feet more or less  
to Little Sarasota Bay, thence southerly 16°  
feet, thence South 76° 30' West 500 feet more  
or less to the Gulf of Mexico, thence northerly  
along the Gulf of Mexico 272 feet to the point  
of beginning, which said property is the same  
property as Lots Nos. 27 and 28 appearing on  
that certain plat hereto attached, and by  
reference made a part hereof, together with any  
and all riparian rights thereunto belonging on  
the Gulf of Mexico and Little Sarasota Bay.

Subject to taxes for the year 1944 and subsequent years.

Together with all the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, with  
every privilege, right, title, interest and estate, dower and right of dower, reversion,  
remainder and easement thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining:

To Have and to Hold the same in fee simple forever.

And the said parties of the first part do covenant with the said party of  
the second part that they are lawfully seized of the said premises, that they are  
free of all incumbrance, and that they have good right and lawful authority  
to sell the same; and that said parties of the first part do hereby fully warrant  
the title to said land, and will defend the same against the lawful claims of all  
persons whomsoever.






DIAGRAM OF CASEY'S KEY


