ORDINANCE NO. 2004-034

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF SARASOTA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ATLAS, AS PART OF SARASOTA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2003-052, CODIFIED IN APPENDIX I TO THE SARASOTA COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SARASOTA COUNTY; PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING ATLAS; PROVIDING RESTRICTIONS, STIPULATIONS AND SAFEGUARDS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," hereby makes the following findings:

- A. The Board has received and considered the report of the Sarasota County Planning Commission concerning Rezoning Petition No. 03-19, requesting rezoning of the property described herein.
- B. The Board has held a public hearing on the proposed rezoning of the property described herein in accordance with the requirements of Sarasota County Ordinance No. 2003-052, considered the information received at said public hearing.
- C. The rezoning herein granted is consistent with the Sarasota County Comprehensive Plan and meets the requirements of the Zoning Ordinance.
- D. Pursuant to the provisions of Article VII of Chapter 94 of the Sarasota County Code, an evaluation has been completed of the impacts that the proposed rezoning of the property described herein will have on the levels of service for parks, drainage, solid waste, roads, mass transit and water and sewer systems. With the exception of the provisions of Section 3 of this Ordinance, adequate levels of service are anticipated to be available.

Section 2. Amendment of the Zoning Ordinance. The Official Zoning Atlas, adopted under Article 4 of the Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification for .37 acres ± from District RSF-3 (Residential, Single Family, 4.5 units/acre) to District OPI/PD (Office, Professional or Institutional/Planned District) for the following described property located in Sarasota County, Florida:

The legal description of said property in Sarasota County, Florida being: At the northeast corner of Bahia Vista Street and Honore Avenue, being more particularly described as follows;

Commence at the intersection of the centerline of Honore Avenue (100 feet wide) and Bahia Vista Street (100 feet wide); thence Easterly along the centerline of Bahia Vista Street, 50.00 feet; thence N.0°16'20"E., 50.00 feet for a **Point**

of Beginning; thence N.89°54'00"E., along the North R/W line of Bahia Vista Street, 100.00 feet; thence N.0°16'20"E., 164.49 feet; thence S.89°58'24"W., 100.00 feet to the East R/W line of Honore Avenue; thence S.0°16'20"W., 164.27 feet along said R/W to the **Point of Beginning**. Lying and being in Section 25, Township 36 South, Range 18 East, Sarasota County, Florida.

Section 3. Restrictions, Stipulations and Safeguards. As used in the stipulations hereinafter set forth, the term "Owner" shall refer to the owner or owners of the property described in Section 2 and their successors and assigns. Upon recording in the public records of Sarasota County, these stipulations shall be covenants running with the land. The use of the property described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, in addition to the applicable restrictions imposed by the Zoning Ordinance, is hereby further limited by and subject to the following restrictions, stipulations and safeguards:

- 1. The Owner shall be required to maintain the appearance and function of any private drainage facilities to be constructed on the site, including retention ponds and drainage ditches, at its own expense in accordance with applicable federal, state or local regulations. At the time of recording a plat or prior to final construction approval, the Owner shall be required to record in the public records a Notice to Purchaser, approved by Sarasota County, putting purchasers on notice that the maintenance of drainage facilities is a private responsibility.
- Access to the subject parcel on Honore Avenue shall be limited to right-in/right-out turning movements only. Left turns shall be prohibited at the right-in/right-out access by a median or raised concrete traffic separator. The improvements shall be included in the construction plans.
- 3. Prior to any OPI use the subject parcel must connect to central sewer and the septic system properly abandoned.
- 4. Master Surface Water Management Plans, submitted for development, shall be consistent with the Phillippi Creek Basin Master Plan.
- 5. During development of the subject property, all vegetative species contained within Section 54-621 of Sarasota County's Exotic Plant Code, state regulations (Chapters 5B-57.007 and 62C-52.011, FAC), and the Florida Exotic Pest Plant Council's list of Category I and II invasive species, as appropriate to this geographic region, shall be removed from the property. Any such vegetation removed from required landscape buffers shall be replaced with native species as part of an approved landscape plan. Removed vegetation shall be disposed of in a County approved landfill or by another method approved by Resource Protection.
- 6. Development shall occur in substantial accordance with the Development Concept Plan datestamped September 16, 2003, and attached hereto as Exhibit "A." This does not imply or confer any variances from applicable zoning or land development regulations. This zoning



map amendment is governed by the provisions of sub-section 1.9.2.b.2.i. of Ordinance No. 2003-052. As a result, the following stipulations shall apply:

- a. Development shall occur in substantial accordance with the Development Concept Plan date-stamped September 16, 2003, and attached hereto as Exhibit "A." This does not imply or confer any variances from applicable zoning or land development regulations.
- b. At the time of Site and Development Plan review and approval, the provisions and requirements of Zoning Ordinance No. 75-38, revised and updated through Amendment No. 196 (Ordinance No. 2001-054, adopted October 15, 2001) shall apply as to matters depicted on the Development Concept Plan and the provisions and requirements of Ordinance No. 2003-052 shall apply to the extent that they do not conflict with the Development Concept Plan.
- c. Any deviations from the Development Concept Plan that are not allowed by this rezoning ordinance (that is, what is not in substantial accordance with the Concept Plan), or amendments must comply with the zoning code in effect at the time of approval of that modification.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from the Office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with said office.

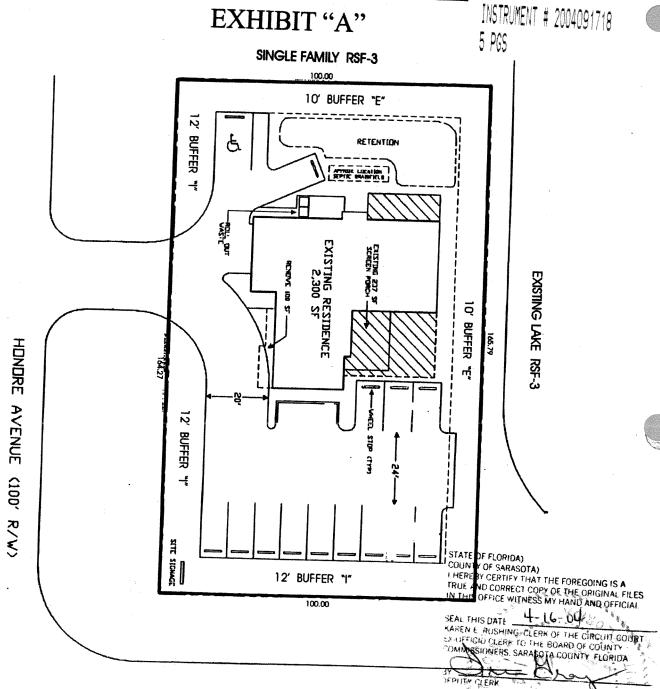
