## RESOLUTION NO. 2014. 196 OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA SPECIAL EXCEPTION NO. 1728

WHEREAS, Robert Keefe, Agent for the Owner of the hereinafter described real property, has filed Special Exception Petition No. 1728 requesting that a special exception be granted to allow outdoor storage on approximately 3.7 acres located at 1301 Sarasota Center Blvd., Sarasota County, Florida, in the PID (Planned Industrial Development) zone district, and

- 1. The proposed use is consistent with the intent, goals, objectives, policies, guiding principles and programs of the Comprehensive Plan;
- 2. The proposed use is compatible with the existing land use pattern and designated future uses;
- 3. There are adequate public facilities available consistent with the level of service standards adopted in the Comprehensive Plan, and as defined and implemented through the Sarasota County Concurrency Management System Regulations, Chapter 94, Article VII of Exhibit A of the Sarasota County Code;
- 4. The proposed use, singularly or in combination with other special exceptions, will not be detrimental to the health, safety, morals, order, comfort, convenience, or appearance of the neighborhood or other adjacent uses by reason of any one or more of the following: the number, area, location, height, orientation, intensity or relation to the neighborhood or other adjacent uses;


